Aspen Park Trails

Aspen Park is located in the southeast portion of the City of Gaylord at the east end of Commerce Boulevard.

There are nearly two miles of barrier-free, paved trails and almost three-quarters of a mile of unimproved trails that meander through this 100-acre park. The park and its trail system are used in the summer months by bikers, hikers, and skaters enjoying the natural wonders of this gently rolling wooded terrain. The trails are open, as well, in the winter. Expertly groomed cross-county ski trails that range in degree of difficulty from beginner

to intermediate provide the cross-county ski enthusiast an opportunity to journey through both hilly and wooded areas.

Two miles of trails are lighted for night skiing.

It is common to see plentiful wildlife throughout Aspen Park. In fact, an active beaver lodge can be found near the park's western boundary.

Paved parking is available at the park entrance. Other amenities include tennis courts, picnic

tables, and benches.

The Northern Michigan Chapter of the Michigan Mountain Bike Association is also completing single-track, novice to intermediate rated trails in the park that will be a joy to ride.

The paved trail system was constructed in 2001 with funding assistance from the Department of Natural Resources through the Clean Michigan Bond Initiative.
