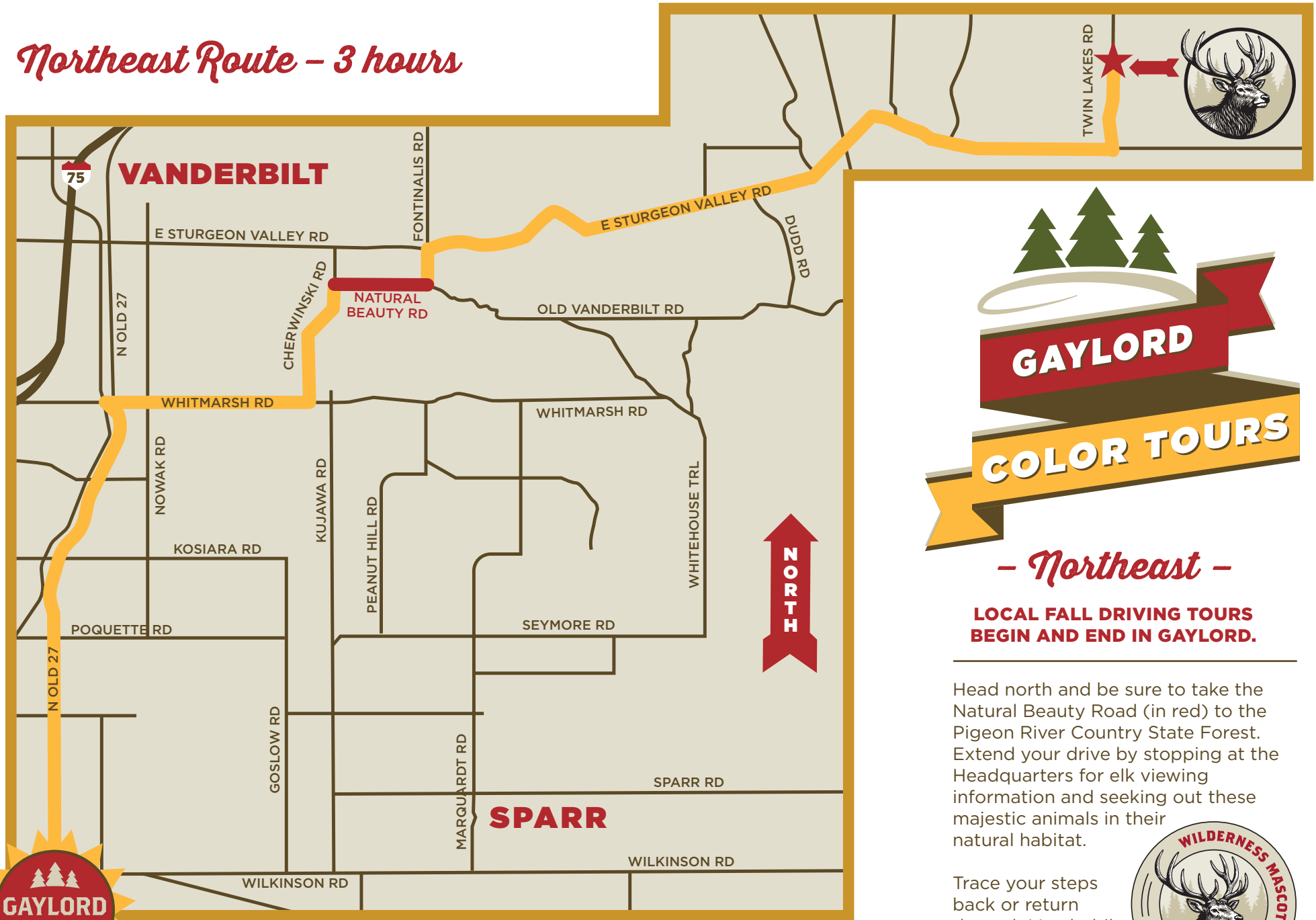


## Northeast Route – 3 hours

To get to Deadman's Hill, take M-32 to US-131 and turn left. Turn right on Deadman's Hill Road.

This overlook is a stunner in every season, but autumn gets full bragging rights. An easy walk uphill from the parking area will treat you to views of the Jordan River Valley you will remember for a lifetime.
